"Shahane Karuni Sodave Sakal Jan" is the motto of the college. Initially it was named as Arts and Commerce College, Kurduwadi and only had two faculties- Arts and Commerce. Later onthe name of the college was changed and it was recognized as K. N. Bhise Arts and Commerce College, Kurduwadi. Afterwards, when the Science Faculty was started by the Sanstha and received permanent affiliation, the name of the college was changed and now it is recognized as K. N. Bhise Arts, Commerce and Vinayakrao Patil Science College. The college is named after late founder President K. N. Bhise Malak and Current President of Hon. Vinayakraoji Patil. The college is affiliated to Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur and is recognized under 2f and 12 B section of UGC Act also. The college is reaccredited with B grade by NAAC. One of the major objectives of establishing this college was to cater the need of education of the students from rural area. Since inception, it has been working with a vision to provide quality higher education to the students and to empower them to cope up with the competitive world. The College offers B. A. in six subjects- English, Hindi, Marathi, History, Economics and Geography, B. Com. in one subject i.e. Commerce and B. Sc. in three subjects- Physics, Chemistry and Microbiology.
